Subject: Administration and Scoring Training Dates and Locations for the 2019 Summative ELPAC



Dear LEA ELPAC Coordinator:

The 2018 Summative English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC) is ending May 31, 2018, and planning has begun for the administration of the 2019 Summative ELPAC. To prepare for the 2019 Summative ELPAC, there will be 24 Summative ELPAC Administration and Scoring Trainings held statewide. These California Department of Education-sponsored statewide trainings will take place from October 9 through November 29, 2018. See the [ELPAC 2019 Summative ELPAC Administration and Scoring Trainings Web page](#) for dates. This is a mandatory training, since there are new test items in the 2019 version of the assessment.

The **ETS Recipient** has been allocated a maximum of **0** training participants to attend a 2019 Summative ELPAC Administration and Scoring Training. This training will be a “training-of-trainers” model. The primary focus of the training will be administration and scoring practices for the Speaking domain. Part of the training will be divided into two groups: kindergarten through grade five, and grades six through twelve. It is recommended that you plan accordingly and bring one trainer for the lower grades and one trainer for the upper grades, if applicable. All local educational agency (LEA) staff who intend to provide a regional training must also attend a fall 2018 training, before conducting their own.

Registration will open on **Wednesday, August 15, 2018**. In August, LEA ELPAC Coordinators will receive an e-mail containing registration information for their LEA. Please note that due to the limited number of seats at each training, only the LEA ELPAC Coordinator will be allowed to register participants for the trainings.
