This is a reminder that required registration for the 2019 Summative English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC) Administration and Scoring Trainings (ASTs) opens on **Wednesday, August 15, 2018**.

The 2019 Summative ELPAC testing window is February 1 through May 31, 2019. To prepare for this test administration, there will be 24 Summative ELPAC ASTs held statewide. The statewide trainings, sponsored by the California Department of Education, will take place from October 9 through November 29, 2018.

The ETS has been allocated a maximum of 0 participants to attend a 2019 Summative ELPAC AST. This training will be a “training-of-trainers” model. A portion of the training day will be divided into two groups: kindergarten through grade five in one room, and grades six through twelve in another room. It is recommended that you plan accordingly and bring one trainer for the lower grades and one trainer for the upper grades, if applicable.

On August 14, local educational agency (LEA) ELPAC Coordinators will receive an email containing registration information for their LEA. Please note that due to the limited number

of seats at each training, only the LEA ELPAC Coordinator will be allowed to register participants for the trainings to the LEA's maximum allocation. Any participants registered over the allocation number will be placed on a waiting list.
