The first operational administration of the computer-based Summative ELPAC is underway and for many, this will be the first time administering an online assessment.

Fortunately, the same test delivery system and secure browser that will be used for the Summative ELPAC is also used for the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) online assessments. So, as you undergo preparations for this first administration, we encourage you to reach out to your LEA CAASPP coordinator who has several years of experience working with the online testing systems. If the LEA has a California Longitudinal Achievement Data System coordinator and a technology coordinator, reach out to them to review the data and technology requirements for the Summative ELPAC, as well as for any additional support you may need during this first administration.

To assist LEA ELPAC coordinators and technology coordinators in implementing the technology requirements for online testing, a new web page is available on the ELPAC website.
